**Peter Hartley** 

Professor Hartley is the President of the International Association for Energy Economics (IAEE) and he was the President of the US Association for Energy Economics in 2012. Now he is the George and Cynthia Mitchell Professor of Economics, and a Rice Scholar affiliated with the Energy Studies Program of the James A. Baker III Institute for Public Policy, at Rice University in Houston, Texas. He is also the BHP Billiton Chair in the Business of Resources in the Business School at the University of Western Australia. He regularly publishes in leading energy journals and has been in charge of many important research projects.

#### Ricardo Raineri

Professor Ricardo is the Vice President of the International Association for Energy Economics. He has a Master and Ph.D. in economics from the University of Minnesota, and a Bachelor in Economics, Business Engineering and Master in Economics degrees from Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile. Now he is a professor at Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile, with a longstanding career teaching on issues of economics of regulation, industrial organization, and business strategy. He has an extensive research work addressing challenging energy issues in the areas of business, governance and public policy, regularly publishes in leading energy journals and participate in conferences on energy issues.


