

Call for Managing Editor for The Energy Journal

The Energy Journal invites applications for the position of Managing Editor. A committee has been appointed to initiate the search for a distinguished individual. The committee will nominate a candidate for the approval by the IAEE Council. The *Journal* is a leading, peer-reviewed publication which publishes a blend of theoretical, empirical and policy related papers in energy economics. Articles published in *The Energy Journal* provide rigorous and innovative analyses that are of interest to academics, energy industry professionals, civil servants and regulators, and the financial community. The *Journal* also publishes book reviews. Candidates should have exceptional skills in energy economics and research, teamwork, and communication. The main responsibilities include management of peer-review of submissions to regular and special issues of the *Journal*, coordination of the book-review process, preparation of reports on *Journal* activities, and participation in promotion and marketing of the *Journal*.



The position is expected to be part-time. There will be an initial 6-month trial period, followed by a three-year term with potential renewal. Applicants should compile the following as a single pdf document and send by email to EnergyJournal@iaee.org.

1. Cover letter.
2. Curriculum Vitae, which includes a record of peer-reviewed publications, editorial experience, and other prior involvement with professional journals.
3. A short statement (max 1 page) about your leadership and management philosophy and experience.
4. A sample of recently published peer-reviewed work.

The deadline for applications is 5:00 PM EDT November 30, 2017. The decision will be made in December and work should begin early January 2018. We consider candidates without regard to race, sex, color, creed, religion, age, national origin or sexual orientation. Compensation is to be determined.
