You as author(s) of the submitted material warrant that it is original and has not been published previously, that it contains no matter unlawful in content or in violation of the rights of any third party, and that the author(s) have the power to grant all of these rights.

Please note that IAEE will freely grant, upon application to IAEE by the author(s), permission to reuse material in the paper or to republish the paper in any recognized scholarly or professional journal, subject only to full credit appearing in the publication, acknowledging first publication by IAEE.
