



Graduate Scholarship in Energy Economics

The Canadian Association for Energy Economics (CAEE) is pleased to announce a new academic scholarship program for graduate studies in energy economics in Canada. The total annual award is \$5,000.00.

Applicants must be registered as full-time, regular students in good standing in a master's or doctoral program at a Canadian university during the term of the award.

The scholarship may be awarded to students pursuing research-based graduate degrees (e.g., economics, engineering) as well as students pursuing professional graduate degrees (e.g. MBA, Law), subject to energy economics being the focus of research or professional training.
