Deadline for abstract submission: May 15, 2014

This year's PhD Day will take place in Roma, at the margin of the 14th European IAEE Conference. It will be a joint event of the IAEE and YEEES. The PhD Day's main objective is to provide selected PhD candidates with a platform for presenting an in-depth version of their work in the field of energy economics. The Special PhD Session shall deepen the exchange among PhD candidates and between junior and senior scientists. Each presenter will get 30 minutes to present his/her work, which will be followed by a detailed and valuable feedback provided by two senior researchers, and questions from the audience.

Please submit an abstract of one to two pages in length, comprising (1) overview, (2) methods, (3) results, and (4) conclusions. The lead author submitting the abstract must provide complete contact details: mailing address, phone, fax, e-mail etc. Only papers written by PhD students (registered as such at the time of the abstract submission) will be considered.

The deadline for abstract submission is set to May 15th. If you are an IAEE member, please submit your abstract to Patrick Narbel (Patrick.Narbel@nhh.no). YEEES members should submit their abstract to Jonas Egerer (je@wip.tu-berlin.de). Authors will be notified by June 30th of their paper status. Authors whose abstracts are submitted will have to submit their full-length papers (20 page limit) by August 14.

To be eligible for consideration, the applicant must:

- Be a full-time student as of the application deadline;
- Be a member of IAEE or YEEES in good standing.

The paper must:

- Be original work completed by the student;
- Not be co-authored by a faculty member or non-student.

Further note that if you would like to present your paper at the Conference event if it does not get accepted for the Special PhD Session (and thus get presented in a concurrent session) you must follow the regular paper submission procedures, submitting an abstract by the regular Call for Papers cut-off date.

The European IAEE Conference will start on October 28 at 18:00 with the Welcome Reception at the LUISS University of Rome.

We look forward to receiving your abstract.
