

IAEE European PhD-students Day

The PhD Day initiative was created for the first time during the 2009 IAEE European Conference in Vienna. It was organised by the Austrian Student Chapter under the leadership of Christian Redl in cooperation with the French and German student chapters of the corresponding national affiliates of IAEE. As such, this event was viewed as the First IAEE European Student Day. IAEE desires to development further events of this kind.

In order to develop this initiative and to promote the collaboration between Student Chapters, the International Association for Energy Economics (IAEE) together with the Swedish Association of Energy Economics (SAEE) and the Stockholm School of Economics plan to host a European PhD-students Day accompanying the 34th IAEE International Conference (19 to 23 June 2011).

The PhD Day will take place at Stockholm School of Economics on 19 June 2011¹. The main objective is to provide a platform for presenting an in-depth discussion of research of PhD-students in the field of energy economics. The PhD Day shall deepen the exchange among PhD-students and between junior and senior scientists. The objective of this PhD Day is not to replace student participation in the 34th IAEE International Conference! The organisers of the 34th IAEE International Conference fully anticipate students who have already had their abstracts accepted for presentation in Stockholm to still present in traditional Concurrent Sessions.

The IAEE, in cooperation with the Austrian, German, French, Italian, Swiss and Norwegian student chapters, will organise sessions on different topics of energy economics. Student speakers must submit their papers in advance to allow preparation of session chairs. The schedule of the PhD Day aims to allow for increased available discussion time for each paper compared to regular IAEE conferences. All student participants of the 34th IAEE International Conference will be invited to attend the PhD Day and efforts will be made to bring in senior researchers and practitioners.
